#### Study Background & Purpose

In December 2013, BioClinica and Clinical Informatics News conducted a survey within the biotechnology and pharmaceutical sector on clinical operations business intelligence and reporting. The purpose of the study was to determine what reporting and business intelligence challenges are faced, what types of data reporting is needed in clinical operations, as well as to gain an understanding regarding risk-based monitoring and reduced Source Document Verification.

With 142 respondents, the study is projected to carry a margin-of-error under 2%.
